





Euan MacDonald MBE



Euan found out he had **MND** 15 years ago. He is now a powerchair user and speaks to people using technology he controls with his eyes.



MND stands for Motor Neurone Disease. It is a condition that affects your brain and nerves, and causes weakness that gets worse over time.



Euan realised there was not enough information for disabled people about the places he wanted to go.



So Euan and his sister Kiki started **Euan's Guide** to give disabled people the information they need when visiting new places.



Euan's Guide is a website which makes it easier for disabled people to find great places to go.



Euan has also:

- launched SpeakUnique - a service that uses computers to make voices for people who can't speak



- set up the Euan Macdonald Centre for MND Research in Edinburgh with his father.
